Mentored by Riccardo Muti at the Italian Opera Academy since 2015, Vladimir Ovodok's international career started in 2017 at the Ravenna Festival with the invitation to conduct the Orchestra Giovanile Luigi Cherubini in the production of Opera Trilogy directed by Cristina Mazzavillani Muti.

Chief Conductor of the Symphony Orchestra of the Opera Studio at the Belarusian State Academy of Music, Vladimir Ovodok works frequently with Moscow Philharmonic Orchestra and the Symphony Orchestra of the National Belarusian Television and Radio in Minsk.
